



When we take the Luas Green Line to travel to 14 Henrietta Street, we will get off at the Broadstone - University | An Chloch Leathan - Ollscoil Luas stop.



We are looking for the nearest gate to King's Inn Park, which is across the road.

We will see a colourful coffee shop container. We will walk past this towards the pedestrian crossing at the traffic lights.



There is a pedestrian crossing to the park beside the metal bollards at the traffic lights.



We will wait here until the light goes green and we will walk across the road and through the archway into the park.





A big metal sign with “King’s Inns Park” will be on our left as we walk down the path towards the large building.



We will walk past the front door of this building towards the metal gate and archway.



We walk through this archway and into a courtyard.



We will walk along this footpath towards Henrietta Street.



Leaving the King's Inns gates, we walk along the right hand side of the road, past the King's Inns Building.





14 Henrietta Street in our right hand side. It will be signposted by colourful bollards outside.



Depending on the weather, the door will be open or closed. If the door is closed, just give it a push.



When you arrive, just give the name your booking is under to the person at reception.
